Our impact reporting methodology

This study analysed the performance of small and medium size Kiwi owner managed businesses we have worked with, which fall into the enterprise size by annual income bracket of \$1M-100M.

Data from over 900 unique businesses was collected primarily between 2017 and 2023, with businesses anonymized to ensure confidentiality.

The results reported fall within a high confidence interval, however missing data points in a series of an organisation's longitudinal reporting have been averaged to fit the model.

Disclaimer:

The Icehouse reports these numbers based on information obtained through an annual survey, financial statements, and other media sources to obtain impact data. Revenue, FTE and export averages are applied and extrapolated over the full network of companies The Icehouse has taken into account outlier organisations that may skew the data.
